- Recognizing the greater linkages between both the Parties in the field of education, training and research;
- Pursuant to the prevailing needs, and norms in their respective commercial endeavors;
- Have agreed as follows:

**Article I  
Objective**

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding / Working Draft is to develop knowhow about share markets, investment products, and to promote awareness, skill development, among the public at large. Further, all the major activities conceived by either of the parties will be co-organized by them.

**Article II  
Financial Arrangements**

M/s. Ambition Group shall keep a caution money of Rs. 5,00,000/- with More Reliable Multivision Agro Advertising, Marketing, Sales Services, Baramati and another Rs. 1,00,000/- with Anekant Institute of Management Studies(AIMS), Baramati. The Caution Money shall be paid in four installments (25% each) at the last day of January to April, 2019. Likewise, the same may be refunded (without interest) in four installments (25% each) at the last day of January to April on termination of the MoU. I

The costs of the co-operative activities under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be funded by Investors. Revenue sharing of the activities shall be 5% of the investment to More Reliable Multivision Agro Advertising, Marketing, Sales Services, Baramati and 1% of the investment to AIMS, Baramati after the deal is materialized.

Further, in case of students services and involvement will be against suitable remuneration by Ambition Group of Companies, Baramati.

It is mutually agreed that Ambition Group of Companies shall provide job opportunities to MBA students of AIMS, Baramati in the area of Finance Specialization.

Further, the payment shall be settled as One Time Settlement before 31<sup>st</sup> March of every financial year.

- iii) In certain circumstances where the meeting cannot be held, mutual consultations and exchange of documents shall be made through electronic media in lieu of such meeting.

### Article V Amendment

Either Party may request in writing for a revision of or amendment to this Memorandum of Understanding. Such revision or amendment shall come into effect on such a date as may be determined by both parties and shall form an integral part of this Memorandum of Understanding.


### Article VI Settlement of Dispute

Any dispute arising out concerning the interpretation or implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through consultation and negotiation by the Parties.

### Article VII Entry into Force, Duration, and Termination

1. This Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the date of its signing.
2. This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force by mutual consent, unless either Party notifies in writing of its intention to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding six months in advance.













